Since our November 2019 Biennial, Companis has made 121 placements with 53 nonprofit partner agencies in King and Snohomish counties. In 2021, we've made 48 Companis Worker placements with 31 nonprofit partners.

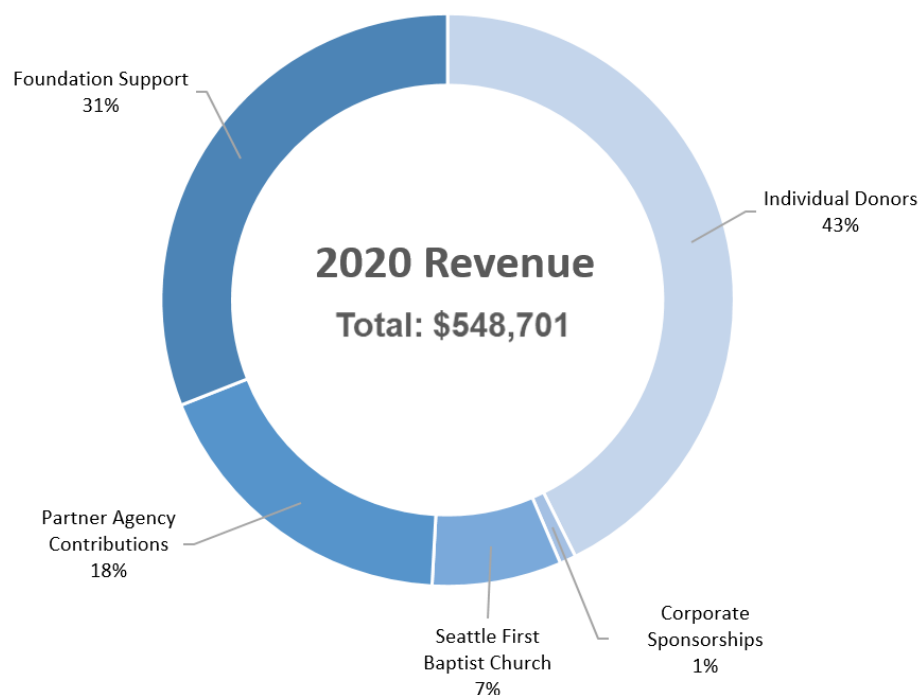
During the COVID pandemic, requests for our services from our nonprofit partners have increased more than three-fold, and continue to grow.

From November 2019 to September 2021, Companis Workers have served 55,787 of our neighbors (unduplicated). This year alone, more than 27,458 of our neighbors have been served directly across our 31 nonprofit partners.

Our placements not only help our partner agencies meet their clients' needs, they also result in an average annual savings of \$1.26 M in professional services delivered by our Workers - funds our partners did not otherwise have to raise.

In 2021 Companis expanded our services to include Snohomish County, in addition to our robust Seattle/King County base, thanks to a grant from the Community Foundation of Snohomish County. As of October 1st, 13 Worker placements are serving seven nonprofit partners in the county, offering access to health care services, behavioral health programs, and support for kids, women, and families.
